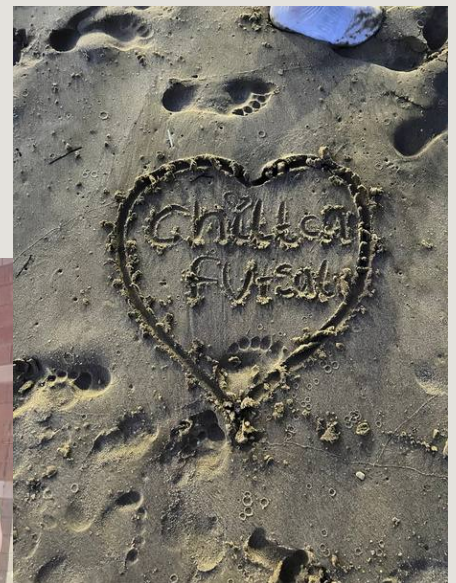
- Since 2022, Chiltern Futsal has provided a welcoming and inclusive environment where young people can learn to play and enjoy Futsal

• **Where Your Support Goes**

- Your session fees help us cover the day-to-day costs of running Chiltern Futsal. But keeping sessions affordable means we need additional support to grow, reach more young people and make the club sustainable for the future.
- What does it cost to run Chiltern Futsal?
- A lot happens behind the scenes to make each session possible.
- Facilities: Around £50 per hour for a single court, often paid 4–6 weeks in advance.
- Coaching: We currently rely heavily on volunteers, alongside paid coaches. We want to increase the number of paid coaching opportunities so we can attract and retain high-level coaches.
- Coach development: FA qualifications, national futsal courses and higher-level coaching qualifications all require investment.
- Equipment: Goals can cost £800–£1,200 per set, while futsal balls cost around £10–£20 each.
- Coach kit & safeguarding: Kit, DBS checks, First Aid and safeguarding training all carry costs.
- Administration: Accounts, payment processing, insurance, affiliation, software, website hosting and other essential running costs.
- Supporting young people: We want to continue providing subsidised places, additional support and opportunities to take part in international experiences.
- Communications: Social media and promotion help us reach more players, families, volunteers and supporters.
- But here's the important part...
- Chiltern Futsal has been built on an incredible amount of donated time and support.
- For four years, trustee Mary has provided coaching & administration completely free of charge. This included the set up of the limited company and charity plus accounting systems and all design work
- all donated at no cost to the charity.
- Cars, phones and other resources have been donated, and several coaches continue to give their time voluntarily.
- We know how lucky we are — and we are incredibly grateful

Now we need to make it sustainable.

- We don't want Chiltern Futsal's future to depend on a small number of individuals continuing to give more and more of their time and resources.
- Our aim is to build a sustainable club where volunteers are supported, coaches can be retained and developed, and more young people can benefit from everything futsal has to offer.

That's why every bit of external support matters.
